# **DPS CHEATS and TIPS!**CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR ALABAMA

- 1. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on an interstate highway is:
- 70 mph.
- 2. Alcohol impairs your:
- Judgment.
- 3. If there is a conflict between the signal light and the directions of a police officer:
- Obey the police officer not the light.
- 4. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
- · Drive more than 200 feet.
- · Pass other vehicles.
- 5. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:
- Permit law enforcement officers to test for the presence of drugs or alcohol if there is a suspicion that you may be driving under the influence.
- 6. When passing, it is against the law to:
- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.
- 7. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in an urban district is:
- 30 mph.
- 8. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 9. A yellow arrow means:
- The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).







- 10. The "No Zones" on a large truck refers to the:
- · Large blind spots on all four sides of the truck.
- 11. To avoid the possibility of hydroplaning in heavy rains:
- Slow down.
- 12. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

- 19. When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:
- 100 feet before the turn.
- 20. Before you pull out to pass:
- Check your blind spots and make sure that you have plenty of time and room to pass.
- 21. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.
- 22. If you are driving slowly on a two-lane highway or road where passing is unsafe, and five or more vehicles are following you:
- Drive into the turnout areas or lanes to let the vehicles pass.

- 23. If your vehicle starts to skid:
- · Take your foot off the gas
- Do not apply the brakes
- Steer in the direction of the skid then steer in the direction you want the car to go.
- 24. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:
- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.
- 25. When a school bus flashes red lights, you must:
- · Stop from either direction until the children are safely across the street and the lights stop flashing.
- 26. Roads are most slippery:
- Just after it begins to rain.
- 27. Drivers must always yield the right-of-way to:
- · Persons who are blind.
- 28. Alabama law requires that seat belts be used by:
  - The driver and front seat passengers.
- 29. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to
- remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 30. When driving slower than the flow of traffic:
- · Keep right so that others may pass you.
- 31. Most medications taken for \_\_\_\_\_ can make a person drowsy and affect their driving.

- 33. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
- Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- · Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.

- 2 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 35. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:
- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.

- 36. You must use your headlights:
- · Between the hours of sunset and sunrise and anytime visibility is limited due to weather or smoke.
- 37. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:
- · Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.
- 38. You may not pass if:
- The solid yellow line is on your side.
- 39. It is illegal for anyone over the age of 21 to drive with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of \_\_\_\_\_ or higher

- 40. The center of a road used for two-way traffic is marked with a:
- · Solid or broken yellow line.
- 41. You must turn on your headlights:
- · Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.
- 42. A green arrow means:
  - Go. You must proceed in the direction of the arrow after yielding to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
- 43. U-turns are illegal:
- · At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.
- 44. You must never drive to the left of double solid yellow lines or a solid yellow line on your side of the roadway unless you are:
- · Turning left at an intersection.
- · Turning into or out of a private road or driveway.
- In a carpool lane that has a designated entrance on the left.
- Instructed by construction or other signs to drive on the left because your side of the road is closed or blocked.
- 45. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.
- 46. Under Alabama law a driver under the age of 21 can be charged with DUI with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of:
- 0.02.



- 47. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:
  - The driver on the left yields to the driver on the right.
- 48. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:
- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.
- 49. If the road has four or more lanes with two-way traffic, drive in:
- The right lanes except when overtaking and passing.
