DMV CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR DELEWARE

- 1. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 2. When a pedestrian is crossing a public street or highway and the pedestrian is using a walker, a crutch, or an orthopedic cane or wheelchair:
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 3. If the road has four or more lanes with two-way traffic, drive in:
- The right lanes except when overtaking and passing.
- 4. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.
- 5. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:
- · Check traffic behind and beside you.
- Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
- Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
- Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.
- 6. Before entering an intersection:
- Check more than once for motorcyclists.
- 7. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:
- · Only for turning left.
- 8. The center of a road used for two-way traffic is marked with a:
- Solid or broken yellow line.









- 9. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:
- · You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.
- 10. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 11. You may not pass if:
- The solid yellow line is on your side.
- 12. Delaware law requires that seat belts be worn by:
 - The driver and all passengers.
- 13. Always stop for pedestrians:
- · At corners with or without traffic lights, whether or not the crosswalks are marked by painted lines.
- 14. Stop at least _____ from the nearest track when the crossing devices are active.

- 15. The DUI law applies not only for alcohol but also for:
- Any other drug, including prescription and over-the-counter drugs, that can affect your driving abilities.
- 16. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for one year.
- 17. Before changing lanes:
- Look behind and to both sides to see where other vehicles are located.
- 18. A flashing yellow signal light means:
- Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.
- 19. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:
- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.
- 20. A flashing Red signal light means:
- Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.



- 21. An unsupervised driver with a Level One Learner's permit may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:
- 10 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- 22. You cannot make a right hand turn on red if:
- A "No Turn On Red" sign is posted.
- 23. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
 - The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
- 24. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:
- · Solid or broken white line.
- 25. The safest speed is:
- One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.
- 26. If the traffic signal is not working:
- Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.
- 27. Parking is not allowed:
- · Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 28. When a school bus flashes red lights, you must:
 - · Stop from either direction until the children are safely across the street and the lights stop flashing.
- 29. The law that prevents anyone under the age of 21 from consuming alcohol is known as the:

- 30. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
