If Applying for Regular Operator's License (not Learner's Permit)

- At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
- 2. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.
- 3. The DUI law applies not only for alcohol but also for:

- 35. A licensed driver under the age of 17 may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:

- 36. A special freeway lane used only for carpools, buses, motorcycles, or decaled low-emission vehicles is known as a:
- Carpool/High Occupancy Vehicles (HOV) Lane.
- 37. When parking uphill with a curb:
- Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.

- 39. Using the _____ rule will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.
- 2 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 40. Drivers must always yield the right-of-way to:
 - · Persons who are blind.
- 41. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:
- Check traffic behind and beside you.
- Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
- Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
- Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.



- 42. A flashing yellow signal light means:
- Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.
- 43. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

 - · Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 45. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:
 - · Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.

- · Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.
- 47. You must turn on your headlights:
- Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.

- you may never legally drive faster than the posted speed limit, even if you think it is safe to do so.
- 49. In heavy rain, at speeds above 50 mph, your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water; this is known as:
