# DMV CHEATS and TIPS!

## CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR ILLINOIS

### 1. A flashing yellow signal light means:

- Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.

### 2. To avoid tailgating, use the \_\_\_\_\_:

- 3 second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.

### 3. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:

- Do not block the intersection.

### 4. When exiting a freeway or interstate:

- Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.

### 5. It is illegal for anyone over the age of 21 to drive with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of \_\_\_\_\_ or higher.

### 6. If your brakes get wet and start to pull to one side:

- Slow down and gently pump the brakes until they start to work correctly.

### 7. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):

- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.

### 8. In Illinois, if you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:

- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for 3 months.

9. Illinois law requires that seat belts be worn by:

- The driver and all passengers.

10. 10. Most medications taken for \_\_\_\_\_ can make a person drowsy and affect their driving.

11. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:

- Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.

12. When parking either uphill or downhill without a curb:

- Turn the wheels so the vehicle will roll away from the center of the road if the brakes fail.

13. The Basic Speed Law means \_\_\_\_\_:

- You could be cited for driving "too fast for conditions."

14. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:

- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.

15. Before you pull out to pass:

- Check your blind spots and make sure that you have plenty of time and room to pass.

16. A red arrow means:

- STOP." Remain stopped until the green signal or green arrow appears. Do not turn against a red arrow.

17. Medications taken together or used with \_\_\_\_\_ can be dangerous.

18. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:

- The driver on the left yields to the driver on the right.

19. At intersections without "STOP" or "YIELD" signs,

- Slow down and be ready to stop. Yield to traffic and pedestrians already in the intersection or just entering the intersection.

20. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:

- Solid white line.

21. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a school zone is:

- 20 mph.

22. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:

- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.

23. In heavy rain, at speeds above 50 mph, your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water; this is known as:

- Hydroplaning.

24. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on an interstate highway is:

- 65 mph.

25. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:

- No passing is allowed.

26. Before changing lanes:

- Look behind and to both sides to see where other vehicles are located.

27. Red reflectors always mean you are:

- Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.

28. Before entering an intersection:

- Check more than once for motorcyclists.

29. For the first 12 months after receiving their license, drivers under the age of 21:

- May not carry more than one passenger.

30. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:

- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.

31. When entering an interstate or freeway :

- Use the entrance ramp to signal and look for an opening in traffic, adjust your speed to match that of the traffic on the freeway.

32. You can receive a ticket for driving so slowly that:

- You impede or block the safe flow of traffic around you.

33. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:

- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.

34. If the traffic signal is not working:

- Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.

35. Illinois law prohibits the use of cell phones while driving by:

- Anyone under the age of 19.

36. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:

- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

37. When passing, it is against the law to:

- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.

38. Blind spots around a large truck are known as:

- "No Zones".

39. The Zero Tolerance Law is the law that:

- Makes it illegal for anyone under the age of 21 to consume alcohol.

40. When a school bus is flashing its yellow (amber) lights:

- It is about to stop; slow down and prepare to stop.

41. An intersection is considered "blind" if:

- There are no stop signs at any corner and you cannot see for 100 feet in either direction during the last 100 feet before crossing.

42. You may not pass if:

- The solid yellow line is on your side.

43. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:

- Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.

44. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:

- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.

45. When passing a bicyclist in a travel lane be sure to allow at least \_\_\_\_\_ between your vehicle and the cyclist.

- 3 feet

46. A roundabout is an intersection where:

- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.

47. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:

- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.

48. You must turn on your headlights:

- Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.

49. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:

- Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
