1. The center of a road used for two-way traffic is marked with a:
 - Solid or broken yellow line.
2. When parking downhill:
 - Turn your front wheels into the curb or toward the side of the road.
3. Before entering an intersection:
 - Check more than once for motorcyclists.
4. A teen driver with an intermediate driver's license may not transport more than _____ passenger/s under the age of 20.
 - One
5. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
 - Drive more than 200 feet.
 - Pass other vehicles.
6. Before you pull out to pass:
 - Check your blind spots and make sure that you have plenty of time and room to pass.
7. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:
 - Check traffic behind and beside you.
 - Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
 - Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
 - Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.
8. Using the _____ rule will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.
 - 3 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two, ne- thousand three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.

9. An intersection is considered “blind” if:

- There are no stop signs at any corner and you cannot see for 100 feet in either direction during the last 100 feet before crossing.

10. Stop at least _____ from the nearest track when the crossing devices are active.

11. You can receive a ticket for driving too slowly.

12. Following a truck too closely is dangerous because:

- The trucker can't see you and, if he applies his brakes, you could crash into him.

13. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:

- You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.

14. When entering an interstate or freeway:

- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.

15. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:

- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.

16. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:

- No passing is allowed.

17. If your brakes get wet and start to pull to one side:

- Slow down and gently pump the brakes until they start to work correctly.

18. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:

- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

19. Parking is not allowed:

- On crosswalks.
- On sidewalks.
- In bicycle lanes
- In front of driveways.

21. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a residential zone is:

- 35 mph.

22. Kentucky law requires that seat belts be worn by:

- The driver and all passengers.

23. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:

- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.

24. In heavy rain, at speeds above 50 mph, your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water; this is known as:

- Hydroplaning.

25. U-turns are illegal:

- At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.

26. When exiting a freeway or interstate:

- Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.

27. A red arrow means:

- "STOP." Remain stopped until the green signal or green arrow appears. Do not turn against a red arrow.

28. Red reflectors always mean you are:

- Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.

29. A blind pedestrian can be identified by the use of:

- A guide dog or a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip).

30. Pedestrians and drivers must yield the right-of-way to:

- Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.

31. If you must drive in fog or smoke:

- Slow down, turn on your low beam headlights, and be ready for a fast stop.

32. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:

- Only for turning left.

33. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:

- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.

34. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:

- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.

35. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on open highways is:

- 55 mph.

36. You must never drive to the left of double solid yellow lines or a solid yellow line on your side of the roadway unless you are:

- Turning left at an intersection.
- Turning into or out of a private road or driveway.
- In a carpool lane that has a designated entrance on the left.
- Instructed by construction or other signs to drive on the left because your side of the road is closed or blocked.

37. You must use your headlights:

- Between the hours of sunset and sunrise and anytime visibility is limited due to weather or smoke.

38. Alcohol impairs your:

- Judgment.

39. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:

- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.

40. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:

- Solid or broken white line.

41. When a pedestrian is crossing a public street or highway and the pedestrian is using a walker, a crutch, or an orthopedic cane or wheelchair:

- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.

42. A roundabout is an intersection where:

- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.

43. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:

- Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.

44. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:

- On your side of the roadway.

45. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:

- Permit law enforcement officers to test for the presence of drugs or alcohol if there is a suspicion that you may be driving under the influence.

46. A teen driver with an intermediate driver's license may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:

- midnight and 6:00 a.m.

47. A green arrow means:

- Go. You must proceed in the direction of the arrow after yielding to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

48. If your vehicle starts to skid:

- Take your foot off the gas
- Do not apply the brakes
- Steer in the direction of the skid then steer in the direction you want the car to go.

49. The Zero Tolerance Law is the law that:

- Makes it illegal for anyone under the age of 21 to consume alcohol.
