# DOR CHEATS and TIPS!

## CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR MISSOURI

1. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:
  - Permit law enforcement officers to test for the presence of drugs or alcohol if there is a suspicion that you may be driving under the influence.
2. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
  - All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
3. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
  - The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
4. You must never drive to the left of double solid yellow lines or a solid yellow line on your side of the roadway unless you are:
  - Turning left at an intersection.
  - Turning into or out of a private road or driveway.
  - In a carpool lane that has a designated entrance on the left.
  - Instructed by construction or other signs to drive on the left because your side of the road is closed or blocked.
5. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
  - Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.
6. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
  - Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
7. If the road has four or more lanes with two-way traffic, drive in:
  - The right lanes except when overtaking and passing.
8. Missouri law requires that children be placed in federally approved child restraint systems if they are:
  - Under the age of 8 or 4'9" tall.

9. You can receive a ticket for driving too slowly.

10. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:

- They may appear to be much farther away than they really are.

11. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:

- Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.

12. Missouri's Minor in Possession Law:

- Makes it illegal for anyone under the age of 21 to consume alcohol.

13. Do not attempt to pass unless:

- You are sure there is enough clear space ahead to complete the pass safely.

14. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on most roads and highways is:

- 60 mph.

15. A flashing yellow signal light means:

- Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.

16. A red arrow means:

- "STOP." Remain stopped until the green signal or green arrow appears. Do not turn against a red arrow.

17. Alcohol impairs your:

- Judgment.

18. A roundabout is an intersection where:

- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.

19. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must

- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.

20. To avoid tailgating, use the \_\_\_\_\_:

- 3-second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.

21. At intersections without “STOP” or “YIELD” signs,

- Slow down and be ready to stop. Yield to traffic and pedestrians already in the intersection or just entering the intersection.

22. The DUI law applies not only for alcohol but also for:

- Any other drug, including prescription and over-the-counter drugs, that can affect your driving abilities.

23. Missouri law requires that seat belts be used by:

- The driver and all passengers.

24. A red signal light means:

- Stop.

25. Stop at least \_\_\_\_\_ from the nearest track when the crossing devices are active.

- 15 feet, but not more than 50 feet

26. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:

- Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.

27. When a pedestrian is crossing a public street or highway and the pedestrian is using a walker, a crutch, or an orthopedic cane or wheelchair:

- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.

28. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:

- Only for turning left.

29. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:

- Do not block the intersection.

30. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:

- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.

31. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:

- No passing is allowed.

- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.

38. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:

- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.

39. When passing, it is against the law to:

- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.

40. If a "No Turn On Red" sign is posted:

- You cannot make a right hand turn on a red light.

41. When driving slower than the flow of traffic:

- Keep right so that others may pass you.

- Drivers must yield or stop at the marked stop line and without stopping in the crosswalk.

44. If there is a conflict between the signal light and the directions of a police officer:

- Obey the police officer - not the light.

45. When parking uphill with a curb:

- Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.

46. Parking is not allowed:

- On crosswalks.
- On sidewalks.
- In bicycle lanes.
- In front of driveways.

47. When passing a bicyclist in a travel lane be sure to allow at least \_\_\_\_\_ between your vehicle and the cyclist.
