CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR RHODE ISLAND

1. When parking either uphill or downhill without a curb:
 - Turn the wheels so the vehicle will roll away from the center of the road if the brakes fail.
2. For the first 12 months after receiving a Level 2 driver's license, a driver may not transport more than _____ passenger/s under the age of 21.

3. If the traffic signal is not working:
 - Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.
4. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:
 - Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.
5. Hydroplaning occurs:
 - When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water like skis.
6. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
 - Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.
7. If your vehicle starts to skid:
 - Take your foot off the gas.
 - Do not apply the brakes.
 - Steer in the direction of the skid then steer in the direction you want the car to go.
8. Parking is not allowed:
 - Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.

9. When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:

- 100 feet before the turn.

10. The safest speed is:

- One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.

11. Do not attempt to pass unless:

- You are sure there is enough clear space ahead to complete the pass safely.

12. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:

- Check traffic behind and beside you.
- Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
- Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
- Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.

13. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in residential zones is:

- 25 mph.

14. Alcohol impairs your:

- Judgment.

15. The Basic Speed Law means:

- You may never legally drive faster than the posted speed limit, even if you think it is safe to do so.

16. Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities on the road as drivers of motor vehicles:

17. Rhode Island law requires that seat belts be worn by:

18. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:

- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.

21. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:

- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.

22. If you are driving slowly on a two-lane highway or road where passing is unsafe, and five or more vehicles are following you:

- Drive into the turnout areas or lanes to let the vehicles pass.

23. When a pedestrian is crossing a public street or highway and the pedestrian is using a walker, a crutch, or an orthopedic cane or wheelchair:

- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.

24. Between the hours of sunset and sunrise:

- Use your headlights. Never drive with parking lights alone.

25. In Rhode Island, drivers under the age of _____ are prohibited from using a cell phone while operating a motor vehicle.

26. The Basic Speed Law means _____:

- You could be cited for driving "too fast for conditions."

27. Following a truck too closely is dangerous because:

- The trucker can't see you and, if he applies his brakes, you could crash into him.

32. You must follow any lawful orders or directions of:

- Any law enforcement officer or a fireman at the scene who is directing traffic.

33. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:

- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.

34. Under Rhode Island law, a driver under the age of 21 can be charged with DUI if tests show a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of:

- .02 or higher.

35. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the roadway is marked with a:

- Broken yellow line.

36. Before you pull out to pass:

- Check your blind spots and make sure that you have plenty of time and room to pass.

37. At intersections without "STOP" or "YIELD" signs:

- Slow down and be ready to stop. Yield to traffic and pedestrians already in the intersection or just entering the intersection.

38. A flashing Red signal light means:

- Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.

39. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:

- Only for turning left.

40. A roundabout is an intersection where:

- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.

41. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:

- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.

42. A special freeway lane used only for carpools, buses, motorcycles, or decaled low-emission vehicles is known as a:

- Carpool/High Occupancy Vehicles (HOV) Lane.

43. Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a car so you should:

- Allow extra room between you and a motorcyclist ahead.

44. When parking downhill:

- Turn your front wheels into the curb or toward the side of the road.

45. Stop at least _____ from the nearest track when the crossing devices are active.

- 15 feet, but not more than 50 feet

46. When a school crossing guard is in the crosswalk:

- Drivers must yield or stop at the marked stop line and without stopping in the crosswalk.

47. When a school bus flashes red lights, you must:

- Stop from either direction until the children are safely across the street and the lights stop flashing.

48. When entering an interstate or freeway:

- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.

49. When driving in rain or fog:

- Use you low beams only and never drive with parking lights only.
