MVA CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR MARYLAND

- 1. If road or weather conditions are not good:
- Double your following distance.
- 2. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 3. If the road has four or more lanes with two-way traffic, drive in:
- The right lanes except when overtaking and passing.
- 4. Alcohol impairs your:
- Judgment.
- 5. You may not pass if:
- The solid yellow line is on your side.
- 6. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:
- · Solid or broken white line.
- 7. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
- Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
- 8. When a school bus flashes red lights, you must:
- Stop from either direction until the children are safely across the street and the lights stop flashing.
- 9. When parking uphill with a curb:
- Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.







- 10. Always drive on the right side of a two-lane highway except when:
 - Passing.
- 11. Before you pull out to pass:
- Check your blind spots and make sure that you have plenty of time and room to pass.
- 12. It is illegal for anyone over the age of 21 to drive with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of _____ or higher

- 13. When driving in rain or fog:
- · Use your low beams only and never drive with parking lights only.
- 14. Red reflectors always mean you are:
- · Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.
- 15. You can receive a ticket for driving so slowly that:
 - You impede or block the safe flow of traffic around you.
- 16. Blind spots around a large truck are known as:
 - "No Zones".
- 17. When passing a bicyclist in a travel lane be sure to allow at least ______ between your vehicle and the cyclist.

- 18. Between the hours of sunset and sunrise:
- · Use your headlights. Never drive with parking lights alone.
- 19. If there is a conflict between the signal light and the directions of a police officer:
- Obey the police officer not the light.
- 20. If you must drive in fog or smoke:
 - Slow down, turn on your low beam headlights, and be ready for a fast stop.
- 21. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:
- · Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.
- 22. The center of a road used for two-way traffic is marked with a:
- · Solid or broken yellow line.

- 23. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- · Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended.
- 24. Stop at least _____ from the nearest track when the crossing devices are active.

- 25. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:
- They may appear to be much farther away than they really are.
- 26. When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:
- 100 feet before the turn.
- 27. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck.
 Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 28. Maryland law requires that seat belts be used by:
- The driver and front seat passengers next to the door and anyone under the age of 16 no matter where they are seated.
- 29. A red arrow means:
- "STOP." Remain stopped until the green signal or green arrow appears. Do not turn against a red arrow.
- 30. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.
- 31. A driver with an intermediate license cannot operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:
- 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.
- 32. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 33. Following a truck too closely is dangerous because:
- The trucker can't see you and, if he applies his brakes, you could crash into him.
- 34. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:
- On your side of the roadway.
- 35. When driving slower than the flow of traffic:
- · Keep right so that others may pass you.



- 36. If your brakes get wet and start to pull to one side:
 - Slow down and gently pump the brakes until they start to work correctly.
- 37. To avoid tailgating, use the ______
- 3 to 4 second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count
 "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish
 counting, you are following too close.
- 38. Pedestrians and drivers must yield the right-of-way to:
- · Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.
- 39. A roundabout is an intersection where:
- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.
- 40. Before changing lanes:
- Look behind and to both sides to see where other vehicles are located.
- 41. A flashing yellow signal light means:
- · Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.
- 42. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.
- 43. Maryland law prohibits the use of any type of wireless communications device for:
- Drivers under the age of 18.
- 44. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
 - The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
- 45. Under Maryland law, a driver under the age of 21 can have his/her license suspended or revoked if there is evidence of:
- · Any amount of alcohol in the body.
- 46. A driver with an intermediate license cannot transport any passengers for:
- The first six months after receipt of the license.
- 47. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
- Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.



48. Hydroplaning Occurs:

• When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water like skis.

49. U-turns are illegal:

- · At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.
