# DOJ CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR MONTANA

- 1. The Basic Speed Law means:
- You may never legally drive faster than the posted speed limit, even
  if you think it is safe to do so.
- 2. Hydroplaning occurs:
- When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water like skis.
- 3. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
- 4. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
- · Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- · Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
- 5. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
- · All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 6. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:
- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.
- 7. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.
- 8. When parking downhill:
- Turn your front wheels into the curb or toward the side of the road.







- 9. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
- Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.
- 10. Do not attempt to pass unless:
- You are sure there is enough clear space ahead to complete the pass safely.
- 11. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:
- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.
- 12. Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities on the road as drivers of motor vehicles:
- TRUE.
- 13. If there is a conflict between the signal light and the directions of a police officer:
- Obey the police officer not the light.
- 14. Under Montana law, a driver under the age of 21 can be charged with DUI if tests show a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of:
- .02 or higher.
- 15. When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:
- 100 feet before the turn.
- 16. Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a car so you should:
- Allow extra room between you and a motorcyclist ahead.
- 17. When passing a bicyclist in a travel lane be sure to allow at least \_\_\_\_\_\_ between your vehicle and the cyclist.

- 18. Between the hours of sunset and sunrise:
- Use your headlights. Never drive with parking lights alone.
- 19. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- · Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for six months.
- 20. Red reflectors always mean you are:
- · Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.

- 21. The DUI law applies not only for alcohol but also for:
- · Any other drug, including prescription and over-the-counter drugs, that can affect your driving abilities.
- 22. A flashing yellow signal light means:
- Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.
- 23. It is illegal for anyone over the age of 21 to drive with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of \_\_\_\_\_ or higher
  - 0.08
- 24. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:
- · Check traffic behind and beside you.
- · Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
- Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
- Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.
- 25. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:
- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.
- 26. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 27. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:
- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.
- 28. If your vehicle starts to skid:
- · Take your foot off the gas.
- · Do not apply the brakes.
- Steer in the direction of the skid then steer in the direction you want the car to go.
- 29. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:
- · You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.
- 30. Using the \_\_\_\_\_ rule will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.
- 3 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 31. If a "No Turn On Red" sign is posted:
- You can not make a right hand turn on a red light.



- 32. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:
- · Only for turning left.
- 33. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:
- · Solid or broken white line.
- 34. A driver with a First-Year Restricted License may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:
- 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- 35. A red arrow means:
- "STOP." Remain stopped until the green signal or green arrow appears. Do not turn against a red arrow.
- 36. For the first six months after receipt of a First-Year Restricted License, a driver may not transport more than \_\_\_\_\_\_ passenger/s under the age of 18.

- 37. A roundabout is an intersection where:
- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.
- 38. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the entrance ramp to signal and look for an opening in traffic, adjust your speed to match that of the traffic on the freeway.
- 39. Always stop for pedestrians:
- At corners with or without traffic lights, whether or not the crosswalks are marked by painted lines.
- 40. The "No Zones" on a large truck refers to the:
- Large blind spots on all four sides of the truck.
- 41. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:
- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.



- 42. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on most roads and highways is:
- 65 mph.
- 43. A flashing Red signal light means:
- Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.
- 44. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
- 45. You must follow any lawful orders or directions of:
- · Any law enforcement officer or a fireman at the scene who is directing traffic.
- 46. Roads are most slippery:
- · Just after it begins to rain.
- 47. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:
- No passing is allowed.
- 48. Montana law requires that seat belts be worn by:
- The driver and all passengers.
- 49. If your brakes get wet and start to pull to one side:
- Slow down and gently pump the brakes until they start to work correctly.
