WYDOT CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR WYOMING

- Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities on the road as drivers of motor vehicles:
- TRUE.
- 2. The safest speed is:
- One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.
- 3. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 4. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:
- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding.
 Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.
- 5. U-turns are illegal:
- At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- · When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.
- 6. You must turn on your headlights:
- Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.
- 7. If you are driving slowly on a two-lane highway or road where passing is unsafe, and five or more vehicles are following you:
- Drive into the turnout areas or lanes to let the vehicles pass.
- 8. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:
- The driver on the left yields to the driver on the right.







- 9. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:
- They may appear to be much farther away than they really are.
- 10. Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a car so you should:
- · Allow extra room between you and a motorcyclist ahead.
- 11. Wyoming law prohibits:
- Reading or sending a text message from a cell phone or other device while operating a vehicle.
- 12. If there is a conflict between the signal light and the directions of a police officer:
- · Obey the police officer not the light.
- 13. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 14. Medications taken together or used with _____ can be dangerous.
- Alcohol
- 15. The Basic Speed Law means:
- You may never legally drive faster than the posted speed limit, even if you think it is safe to do so.
- 16. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for six to 18 months.
- 17. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.
- 18. The holder of an Intermediate License may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:
- 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- 19. To avoid tailgating:
- Use the 2 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count
 "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are
 following too close.
- 20. When a school bus is flashing its yellow (amber) lights:
- It is about to stop; slow down and prepare to stop.

- 21. Red reflectors always mean you are:
- · Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.
- 22. A flashing Red signal light means:
- Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.
- 23. Pedestrians and drivers must yield the right-of-way to:
- · Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.
- 24. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a school zone is:
- 20 mph.
- 25. When driving in rain or fog:
- · Use your low beams only and never drive with parking lights only.
- 26. Parking is not allowed:
- · Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 27. A roundabout is an intersection where:
- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.
- 28. Always drive on the right side of a two-lane highway except when:
- · Passing.
- 29. Blind spots around a large truck are known as:
- "No Zones."
- 30. The holder of an Intermediate License may not transport more than ______ passenger/s under the age of 18.

32. Hydroplaning occurs:

- When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water like skis.
- 33. Under Wyoming law, a driver under the age of 21 can be charged with DWUI if tests show a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of:
- .02 or higher.
- 34. Before entering an intersection:
- · Check more than once for motorcyclists.
- 35. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:
- · No passing is allowed.
- 36. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- · Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.
- 37. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 38. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:
- Only for turning left.
- 39. You may not pass if:
- The solid yellow line is on your side.
- 40. When parking either uphill or downhill without a curb:
- Turn the wheels so the vehicle will roll away from the center of the road if the brakes fail.
- 41. When parking uphill with a curb:
- Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.



- 42. If a "No Turn On Red" sign is posted:
- · You can not make a right hand turn on a red light.
- 43. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:
- · Do not block the intersection.
- 44. A red signal light means:
- · Stop.
- 45. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:
- Solid or broken white line.
- 46. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:
- Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.
- 47. A yellow arrow means:
- The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).
- 48. A green arrow means:
- Go. You must proceed in the direction of the arrow after yielding to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
- 49. Wyoming law requires that seat belts be worn by:
- The driver and all passengers.
