DMV CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR SOUTH CAROLINA

- 1. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:
- They may appear to be much farther away than they really are.
- 2. A driver with a Special Restricted license may only drive alone during:
- Daylight hours.
- 3. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:
- · Check traffic behind and beside you.
- Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
- Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
- Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.
- 4. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:
- Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.
- 5. Between the hours of sunset and sunrise:
- Use your headlights. Never drive with parking lights alone.
- 6. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for six months.
- 7. A driver with a Special Restricted license may not transport more than ______ passenger/s under the age of 21.

- 8. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:

- 9. What is the fastest way to sober up after drinking?
 - Time is the only thing that will get alcohol out of your system. Coffee and cold showers do not work; the alcohol has to be burned off by the liver and the amount of time that takes is different for everyone.
- 10. The safest speed is:
- One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.

- 12. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.

- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.

- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.

- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.

- 39. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.

- The solid yellow line is on your side.
- 41. If the road has four or more lanes with two-way traffic, drive in:
 - The right lanes except when overtaking and passing.



- 42. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
 - Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
- 43. Always stop for pedestrians:
 - At corners with or without traffic lights, whether or not the crosswalks are marked by painted lines.
- 44. Parking is not allowed:
- Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 45. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a residential zone is:
 - 30 mph.
- 46. Do not attempt to pass unless:
- You are sure there is enough clear space ahead to complete the pass safely.
