CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR ALABAMA

1. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on an interstate highway is:
 - 70 mph.
2. Alcohol impairs your:
 - Judgment.
3. If there is a conflict between the signal light and the directions of a police officer:
 - Obey the police officer - not the light.
4. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
 - Drive more than 200 feet.
 - Pass other vehicles.
5. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:
 - Permit law enforcement officers to test for the presence of drugs or alcohol if there is a suspicion that you may be driving under the influence.
6. When passing, it is against the law to:
 - Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.
7. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in an urban district is:
 - 30 mph.
8. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
 - Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
9. A yellow arrow means:
 - The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).

- Take your foot off the gas
- Do not apply the brakes
- Steer in the direction of the skid then steer in the direction you want the car to go.

24. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:

- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.

25. When a school bus flashes red lights, you must:

- Stop from either direction until the children are safely across the street and the lights stop flashing.

26. Roads are most slippery:

- Just after it begins to rain.

27. Drivers must always yield the right-of-way to:

- Persons who are blind.

28. Alabama law requires that seat belts be used by:

- The driver and front seat passengers.

29. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:

- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.

37. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:

- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.

38. You may not pass if:

- The solid yellow line is on your side.

39. It is illegal for anyone over the age of 21 to drive with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of _____ or higher.

40. The center of a road used for two-way traffic is marked with a:

- Solid or broken yellow line.

41. You must turn on your headlights:

- Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.

42. A green arrow means:

- Go. You must proceed in the direction of the arrow after yielding to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

43. U-turns are illegal:

- At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.

44. You must never drive to the left of double solid yellow lines or a solid yellow line on your side of the roadway unless you are:

- Turning left at an intersection.
- Turning into or out of a private road or driveway.
- In a carpool lane that has a designated entrance on the left.
- Instructed by construction or other signs to drive on the left because your side of the road is closed or blocked.

45. When exiting a freeway or interstate:

- Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.

46. Under Alabama law a driver under the age of 21 can be charged with DUI with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of:

47. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:

- The driver on the left yields to the driver on the right.

48. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:

- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.

49. If the road has four or more lanes with two-way traffic, drive in:

- The right lanes except when overtaking and passing.
